The next scheduled meet is the Williamsburg Invitational at the University of the Cumberlands this Friday, May 8.

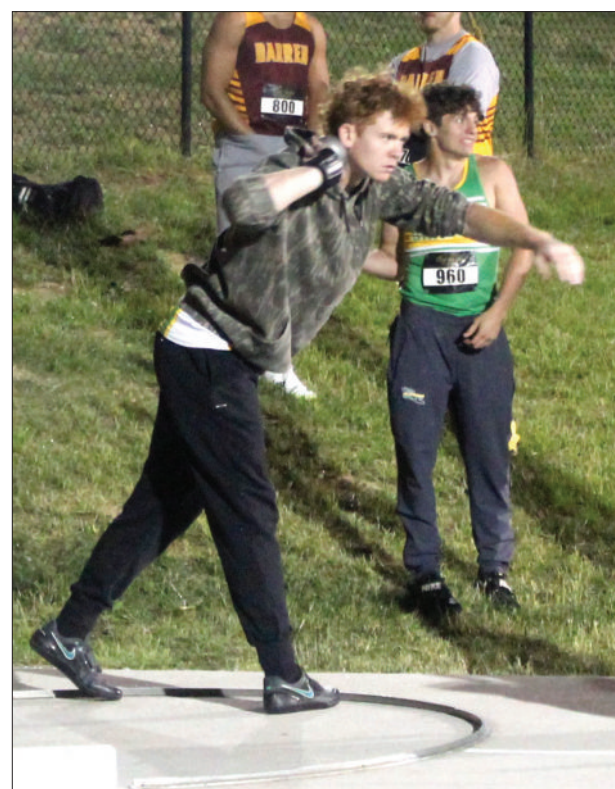
