The Lady Dragons scored 98 points to runner-up South Laurel's 91.

The boys' team finished runner-up to Middlesboro with the Dragons scoring 98.50 points to Middlesboro's 99.

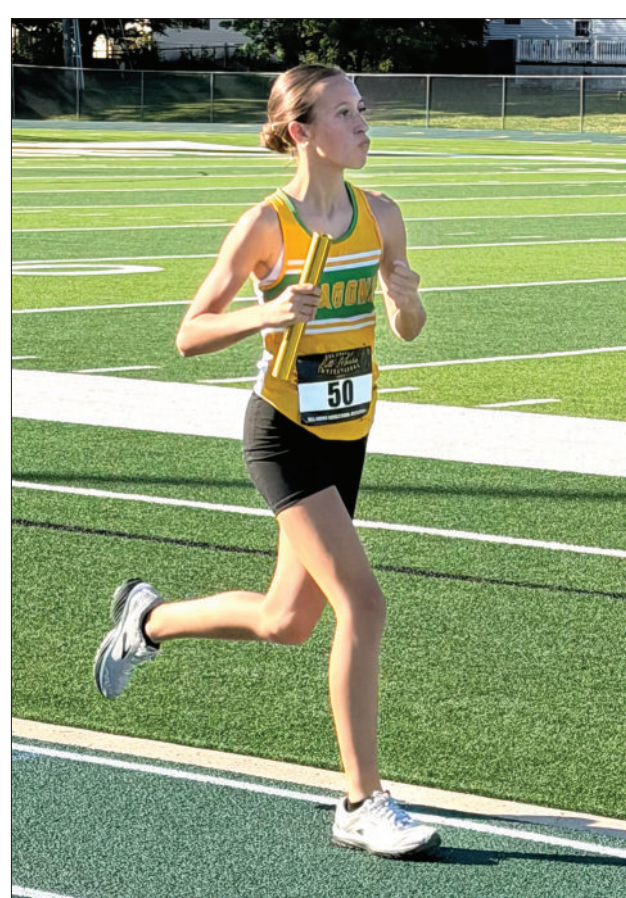
