Dragons run rule LaRue County in Championship

The Green County High School Dragons won the baseball district tournament last week with two shutout games that were so much fun to watch.

The Dragons beat Hart County 4-0 in the semifinals to advance to the championship and then the championship LaRue County 10-0 in five innings to bring home the trophy.

This is Brennen Milby's fourth year as head coach and under his direction, the Dragons have won the district tournament three times and finished runner-up once.

Grif Thomas, a freshman, went the full seven innings against Hart in the opening game. He gave up just three hits over the seven innings while striking out five Raider batters.

The Dragons, the number two seed in the tournament, scored three runs in the bot-

tom of the third inning when Drew Squires sent a home run blast over the center field fence. That was home run number 12 for Squires. That home run also scored Tatum Durrett and Caleb Corbin, who had singled earlier in the inning.

In the next inning, Cash Jones scored the final run for the Dragons on an RBI single by Keelan Curry.

The shutout win by the Dragons set them up against LaRue County for the championship. LaRue had beaten Caverna 15-0 in four innings to win their opening game of the tournament.

With Campbellsville High School having lost their opening round game in the 20th District Tournament to Adair County, LaRue County became the highest rated team in the region, but the Dragons were not intimidated.
