

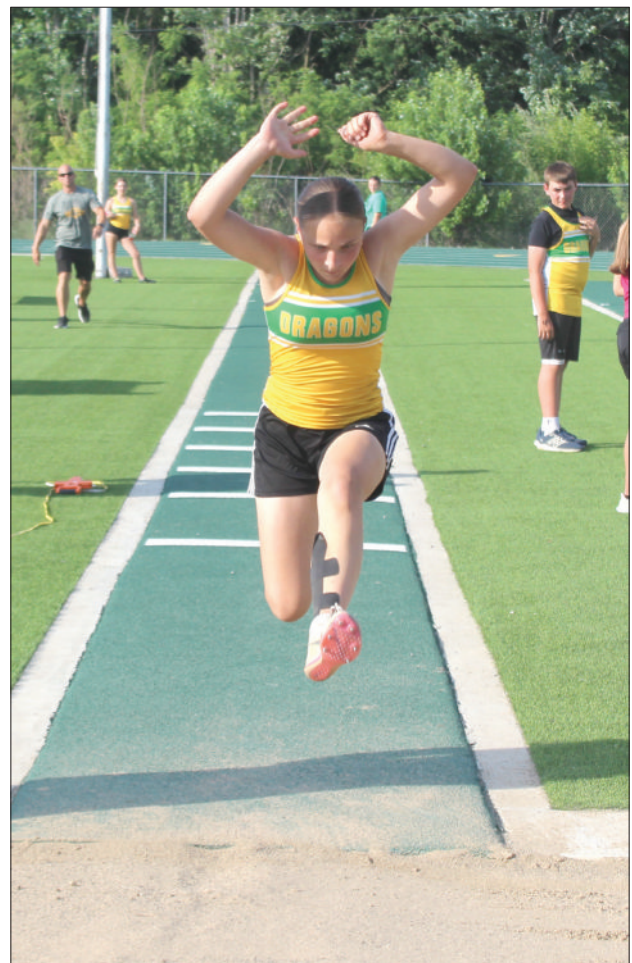
Green County Middle School Track & Field All Comers Meet

Allie Moore launched the ball 22 ft. 3 in. in the girls' shot put event.

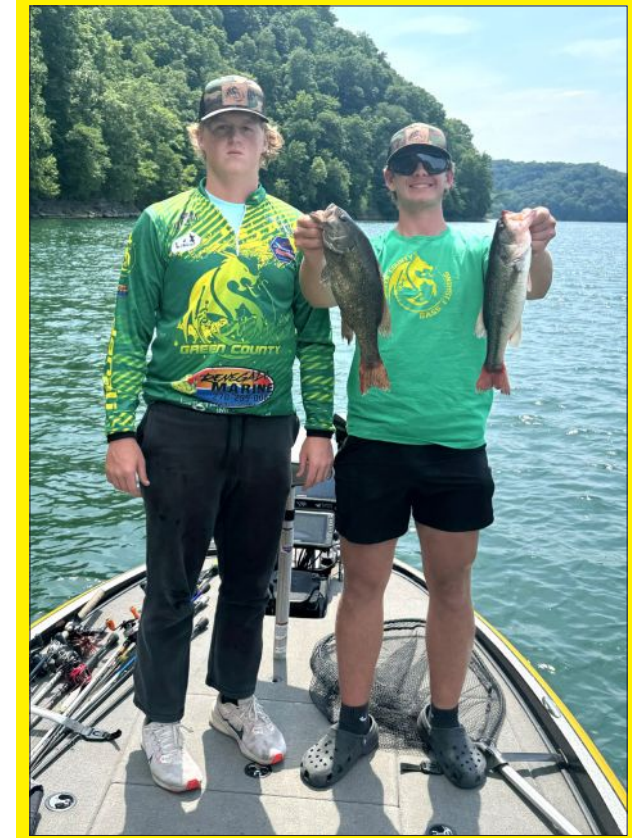


Brayden Clopton, right, competed in the boys' 1600m run with a time of 6:02.65. He finished third overall in the event.
