

# Pedal Pull A Winner With Kids

Tractor pulls are a county fair tradition, and the kids will get their own chance to show what they can do during the Pedal Power Pull at the Clay County Fair.

The free event will be held Sunday, July 12, at 1 p.m. in front of the Fair Office.

Boys and girls ages 4 to 11 are invited to compete, using their own leg power to pull a

weighted sled as far as they can. Contestants will compete against others in their age division, with winners determined by the greatest pulling distance.

Sign-up will take place the



day of the event. Each contestant must have a parent or guardian signature to participate, and pedal tractors and equipment will be furnished.

Medals will be awarded to first, second and third place winners in each age division. Winners will also qualify for the State Pedal Pull. Prior state qualifiers may pull again, but cannot qualify for state a second time.

Every contestant will receive a bottle of milk.
