The Clay County Fair Demolition Derby is back, and it is ready to bring the noise.

Engines will roar, mud will fly and metal will meet metal when drivers roll into the Grandstand at 7:00 p.m. Saturday, July 11, for one of the fair's loudest nights of entertainment.



This year's derby will feature five classes: Full Size Limited Weld, Full Size Unified, Unified Compacts, MWFA and the new 80's and Newer Stock class. Drivers will compete for more than \$12,500 in payouts, with prizes awarded to top finishers in each division!

Fans can expect plenty of fender-bending action as competitors slam, spin and battle to keep their vehicles running longer than the rest. Behind every hard hit is a mix of timing,

strategy, grit and a pit crew working hard to keep cars in the fight.

The first demolition derby at the Clay County Fair was held in 1968, and the event has been drawing cheers ever since.

Pits will be open from 3:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. before the 7:00 p.m. start time.

Adult tickets are \$20 for ages 12 and older, while youth tickets are \$5 for ages 11 and younger.
