

Enjoy the week-long Rodeo Fest

Hawley Rodeo Fest is a week-long tradition in Hawley, which kicks off with BOF and ends with the Saturday night performances of the Barnes PRCA Rodeo. Daily and evening events, like Cowboy Church, the Hawley Health Fair, and the Rodeo Parade, continue to be the cornerstone of the week.

Monday, June 1 is an afternoon and evening geared toward the kiddos. The Hawley Library will host an outdoor story time at Westgate Park at 3:00 p.m.

The Hawley Women of Today (WOT) will hold their annual Little Miss Hawley pageant at the high school auditorium starting at 6:30 p.m.

Also on Monday evening is the rodeo for of the Lil' Riders Rodeo Series at the Rodeo Grounds at 6:30 p.m. People are welcome to sit hillside to watch and cheer on the lil' riders as they saddle up and compete in rodeo events catered to their age groups.

Wednesday, June 4 will begin with the annual Health Fair at the Hawley Community Building put on by Sanford, from 9 a.m. to 10:30 a.m.

Bring the kiddos to Westgate Park at 3 p.m. To make your our stick horse. REACH invites families and individuals back to Westgate Park to play Family Bingo from 4pm to 7pm.

Friday, June 6, the Hawley Fire Department invites the community down to the station for its annual pancake breakfast, from 6 a.m. to 9:00 a.m.

RDO will once again host a Day of Play for the kiddos from 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.

The first Barnes PRCA rodeo will kick off at 7:00 p.m. and generally lasts well after sunset.

The fun will continue with karaoke at 3 Finger Pubs, starting at 9 p.m.

Saturday, June 6, the Rodeo Fest grand finale will have you and the family running every which way, starting with the traditional Hegland Church Rodeo Breakfast at Hawley Lutheran Church from 8 a.m. to 11a.m. Car King Auto of Hawley is sponsoring this year's car show under the Hawley water tower. Registration opens at 8 a.m. and the show runs from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. The Vendor Street fair will also take place under the water tower from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

As the sun stretches across the sky, more activities will pop up downtown, such as dunk a teacher in the dunk tank sponsored by the Hawley PTO, from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. and kids bounce house activities with food and ice cream sponsored by the Hawley Jaycees, from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Dunk your teacher from 11 am to 2 pm. The Hawley Senior Center invites seniors to its annual pie and ice cream social, from 1 p.m. to 4 p.m. The downtown events will end with the annual Rodeo Fest Parade, which starts at 4 p.m. (Keep an eye out for this year's parade route)
