the process in terms that homeowners can understand. They should also discuss potential issues that could arise during the job and how those situations would be handled.

Finally, be cautious of contractors who appear immediately after storms offering quick repairs. While some may be legitimate, others may be temporary crews looking to take advantage of urgent situations. These contractors sometimes complete low-quality work and disappear before problems become visible.
