In 1972, a new judging pavilion was built at the Ringgold County Fair Grounds with the older 4-H members and their leaders working to make the fair grounds look its best.

Junior 4-H camp was well attended. The participants prepared their own lunch wrapped in foil and cooked over a bed of coals. 4-H County Council, boys and girls, members were selected from each Club.

The County Council members assisted in a variety of 4-H activities such as the award program and leader recognition banquet.

The 4-H and Youth Committee was revised to include 5 youth to assist the 5 women and 5 men in making decisions that impacted and strengthened all the 4-H clubs in the county.
