Dept. Of Justice Sues For Access To Illinois Voter Rolls

Illinois among at least 19
states being sued for voter
data

The U.S. Department of Jus-
tice filed suit Thursday against
the state of Illinois seeking access
to its complete, unredacted voter
registration database, includ-
ing sensitive personal data such
as dates of birth, driver's license
numbers and partial Social Secu-
rity numbers.

The lawsuit, which was filed in
U.S. District Court in Springfield,
makes Illinois at least the 19th
state to be sued for such informa-
tion.

The Justice Department has
been seeking that information
since July, but the Illinois State
Board of Elections so far has de-
clined to hand over the informa-
tion, citing both state and federal
privacy laws that it says prohibit it
from handing over such informa-
tion.

Instead, in August, the agency
gave DOJ a copy of the same da-
tabase it makes available under
state law to political parties and
candidates. That file includes vot-
ers' names, addresses and their
age at the time they registered, but
not their date of birth, driver's li-
cense, state ID or Social Security
number.

Federal officials have said they
want the information to deter-
mine whether Illinois is comply-
ing with federal requirements

scrubbing registrations of voters
who have died or moved away
from their listed address.

State officials, however, have re-
sponded that Illinois has a decen-
tralized voter registration system
in which local election authorities
at the city and county level are
responsible for maintaining their
own voter databases.

The lawsuit names State Board
of Elections executive director
Bernadette Matthews as the defen-
dant.

A spokesman for the board said
it has asked Attorney General
Kwame Raoul's office for repre-
sentation in the case. The agency
declined to offer any further com-
ment.
