

# The Midland T-Wolves Roll To Big Wins Over L-P Washburn, LaMoille

The Midland Timberwolves scored a couple of convincing wins this week over L-P Washburn on Friday and LaMoille on Saturday, taking their record up over the .500 mark, now at 9-8.

On Friday, Midland slowly pulled away from the L-P Washburn Wildcats, eventually posting a 70-59 win to capture the Tri-County Conference win.

Midland had six players hit the scoring column in the first quarter as they jumped out to a big 29-9 first quarter lead. It was 40-25 at the half and 58-39 heading into the fourth quarter before the Wildcats trimmed the lead to the 11-point margin, winning 70-59.

Midland had 10 players hit the scoring column led by the 21 points from Dom Rosa.

At home on Saturday, Midland led the entire way enroute to a 73-35 win over LaMoille. The T-Wolves led 34-19 at the half and 50-29 heading into the fourth quarter. Sophomore Brecken Pyles tallied 11 fourth quarter points as Midland pulled away to the 38-point win.

Dom Rosa led the way for Midland as he tallied 21 points. A trio of Midland sophomores tallied double figures as Brecken Pyles, Ian White and Matthew Bumber all added 18, 11 and 10 points respectively.

The T-Wolves did continue to struggle at the free throw line again this week as they converted just 14 of 34 attempts.

Midland will be back in action this week as they host Wethersfield on Wednesday, then remain at home on Friday where they will host Woodland in a

Tri-County Conference matchup. They will begin play in the annual Tri-County Tournament on Saturday, January 24.

# Lady T-Wolves Beat Peoria Central, Earlville, Fall To Roanoke-Benson

The Midland Lady Timberwolves had a busy week, getting wins over Peoria Central on the road on Monday, then defeated Earlville at home on Tuesday. Their lone loss was to a tough Roanoke-Benson team on the road on Friday.

On Monday, Midland took a rare trip down to play Class 3A Peoria Central where they came away with a 50-42 win.

Anna McGlasson scored 12 of her game-high 20 points in the first quarter, staking the T-Wolves to an 16-11 first quarter lead. The lead grew to 29-20. The Lady Lions cut the lead to 43-38 heading into the final quarter, but Midland held Peoria to just two fourth quarter field goals to take the 50-42 win.

"I was proud of the way they handled themselves in an intense environment and in a physical game," stated head coach Xavier Warren.

Besides McGlasson's 20 points, Jordyn Pyles and Ella Foster added double figure scoring with 12 and 10 points respectively.

Midland was deadly from the free throw line in this game, converting 17 of 19 attempts.

In their lone home game on Tuesday, Midland had little trouble with Earlville as they cruised to a 54-22 win.

Midland jumped out to a 15-4 first quarter lead, then held the Lady Red Raiders to just two free throws in the second quarter as they took a 28-6 lead into the half. It was 44-17 heading into the final quarter.

Anna McGlasson led the way for Midland as she tallied 15 points. Emma Franks added double figure scoring with 14.

On Friday, Midland had their modest 3-game winning streak snapped as a poor second quarter led to a 44-28 loss to Roanoke-Benson.

Midland held an 11-9 lead after the first quarter, but managed just a field goal and free throw in the second quarter as the Lady Rock-est poured in 19 to take a 28-14

lead at the half. Roanoke led 36-21 heading into the fourth quarter.

"After a good start, we had one rough quarter," stated Coach Xavier Warren. "You can afford that against a good team."

Anna McGlasson led the way for Midland with 9 points. Emma Franks added 7.

Midland will be competing in the Tri-County Tournament this week.

# Fieldcrest Knights Roll Over Prairie Central, Fall To Dee-Mack

The Fieldcrest Knights split a pair of basketball games this past week, rolling at home on Tuesday to a 62-44 win over Prairie Central, then dropping a conference game on the road to Deer Creek-Mackinaw by a 59-50 score.

On Tuesday, Fieldcrest's Layten Gerdes scored 9 first quarter points sparking the Knights to a 17-7 first quarter lead. Gerdes added 8 more points in the second quarter as Fieldcrest held a comfortable 33-17 lead at the half. It was a 53-33 game heading into the final quarter.

Gerdes finished the game with 23 points. Kash Klendworth and Drew Overocker finished with 13 points apiece.

On Friday night, the Knights lost a tough one as the Dee-Mack Chiefs hit their free throws down the stretch to pull away to a 59-50 win.

The Chiefs held a 29-21 half time lead, but the Knights roared back in the third quarter behind the 9 points each from Layten Gerdes and Drew Overocker to take a 42-41 lead into the final quarter.

The Chiefs were deadly from the free throw line in the fourth quarter as they converted 9 of 10 down the stretch to pull away to the 8-point win.
