

# Lady Knights Roll Over Lexington, Fall To EP-G On Senior Night

The Fieldcrest Lady Knights split a pair of conference games at home this week, defeating Lexington on Monday by a 69-44 score, then dropping a 50-44 short-handed decision to El Paso-Gridley on Senior Night.

On Monday, the Lady Knights jumped out to a 16-7 first quarter score and extended that to 41-15 before pulling away to the 69-44 win.

Fieldcrest had 7 players hit the scoring column led by the 19 points from Macy Gochanour. TeriLynn Timmerman added 14 points while Pru Mangan and Leah Armes added double figure scoring with 12 and 11 points respectively.

On Thursday on Senior Night, the Knights, played without the services of their leading scorer

Macy Gochanour who was nursing an injury.

In spite the that, the Lady Knights kept it close. After a 13-13 first quarter tie, the Lady Titans moved out to a 32-18 halftime lead and led 42-30 after three quarters, holding on to the 50-44 win.

Fieldcrest had balanced scoring, led by Ivory Bryant's 13 points and 16 rebounds. Terilynn Timmerman had 10 points while senior Pru Mangan had added 9.

The Lady Knights will continue conference play this week. After a game Monday at Ridgeview, Fieldcrest will return home on Thursday, February 5 when they host G.C.M.S. They will be on the road next Monday when they travel to University High School for a non-conference game in Bloomington.

# Midland Falls To Marquette, R-B At The Tri-County Tournament

The Midland Timberwolves dropped their final two games at the Tri-County Tournament, falling Monday in the quarterfinals to Marquette, then dropping a 67-49 decision On Thursday to Roanoke-Benson in the consolation round.

On Monday against 2nd seeded Marquette, the T-Wolves kept it close before dropping a 66-57 decision to the Crusaders.

Midland had the lead at 12-11 after the first quarter and trailed by a single point at 28-27 at the half. The Crusaders led 45-39 heading into the final quarter, then converted on 13 of 16 free throws down the stretch to take the 66-57 quarterfinal win.

Dom Rosa had a big game for Midland as he tallied 23 points. Landon McFadden added double figure scoring with 11.

On Thursday in the consolation round, Midland kept it close in the first quarter, but Roanoke-Benson used a 22-10 advantage in the second quarter to jump out to a 39-24 halftime lead. It was a 51-40 game heading into the fourth quarter. Once again, free throws took their toll as Midland converted on just 6 of 24 attempts while the Rockets were 17 of 20 from the line.

Dom Rosa led the way as he tallied 14 points. Landon McFadden added 11.

Midland will take to the road on Tuesday, February 3 when they travel down to Peoria Christian. They will stay on the road Friday when they get a rematch with the Marquette Crusaders. They will return home on Monday, February 29 when they host Bloomington Cornerstone.

# Lady T-Wolves Roll To Three Wins, Stretch Winning Streak To 6 Games
