

Fieldcrest Lady Knights Close Out Regular Season, Win Regional Opener

The Fieldcrest Lady Knights closed out their regular season this past week, falling to U-High and Tremont, then won their opening game of the Fieldcrest Class 1A Regional Tournament on Saturday.

On Monday, led 10-8 after the first quarter and 27-25 at the half. The Lady Knights failed to score in the third quarter as U High took a 43-25 lead after three quarters then coasted to the 62-37 win.

TeriLynn Timmerman led Fieldcrest with 25 points, 8 rebounds, and 6 steals. Ivory Bryant and Leah Armes each added 5 points.

In their regular season finale on Thursday, Tremont jumped out to a 25-6 first quarter lead and never looked back in scoring a 72-46 win. The Lady Turks led 40-19 at the half and 58-36 heading into the final quarter.

TeriLynn Timmerman once again led the Lady Knights as she

tallied 19 points. Leah Armes and Ivory Bryant added double figure scoring with 14 and 13 points respectively.

The Lady Knights finished the regular season with a 13-17 overall record and 4-8 in conference play.

In the opening round of the Fieldcrest Regional on Saturday, the 5th seeded Lady Knights scored a 65-12 over 12th seeded Donovan.

The Lady Knights led 22-4 after the first quarter and 47-9 at the half. It was 61-10 heading into the final quarter.

TeriLynn Timmerman tallied 22 points and 7 steals for Fieldcrest. Ivory Bryant added 13 points and 7 rebounds. Leah Armes scored 9 points while Pru Mangan barely missed a double double with 9 points and 9 rebounds.

Fieldcrest will continue play this week at the Regional Tournament in Minonk.

Lady-T-Wolves Head To Regional Play With A 10-Game Win Streak

The Midland Lady Timberwolves closed out their regular season with a big 74-42 conference win over Marquette on Thursday, February 12. It was the 10th win in a row for Midland who heads to the post season with a 23-7 record.

Midland left little double as to the outcome as they raced out to a 17-8 first quarter lead. Anna McGlasson and Jordyn Pyles combined for 21 of Midland's 23 second quarter points as they took a 35-25 lead at the half. Midland put the game out of reach in the third quarter, taking a 48-31 lead into the fourth quarter.

Anna McGlasson led the way for the Midland as she tallied 25 points. Jordyn Pyles was right behind her with 23 points. Emma Franks added double figure scoring with 11.

Midland now heads to the regional tournament at Serena where they drew the top seed in the Sub Sectional A. On Monday, Midland scored a 52-22 win over Henry-Senachwine in the regional semi-finals. That advanced them to the regional championship game on Thursday where they will face Yorkville Christian (17-11) a 52-25 winner over Serena in the

other semi-final game. That game is set to tip off at 6:00. Should they win the regional, they will compete in the Shabbona Sectional on Tuesday, February 24th at 6:00. They would face the South Beloit regional winner in which Aurora Christian (10-15) is the top seed.

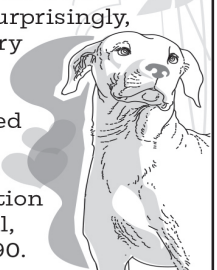
