

Lacon City Council Meets To Conduct Routine Business

The Lacon City Council met briefly last week, approving several outside music permits and street closures for upcoming events in Lacon.

On Wednesday, February 11th, the council approved the Meet at the Marina car show event on May 2nd, along with an outdoor music permit for that event. Another car show event on September 20th was approved with road closures on North Main Street. The outdoor music permit was also approved

for this event in September.

Another outdoor music permit was approved for Rita's Kitchen & Bar for a fundraiser she is hosting in her parking lot on June 7th.

The council also approved the request for the use of Johnson's Park for the Woodford County Duck Blind Drawing on July 26th.
