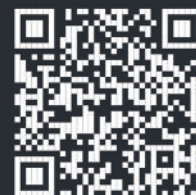
EXCAVATOR HITS INTERSTATE OVERPASS AT OAKLAND

The cargo of a transport tractor trailer rig that apparently was westbound on Highway 32 at Oakland in Yalobusha County, Mississippi, struck the underside of an I-55 overpass there shortly before 5 p.m. Tuesday (June 16). Photos show what appears to be a Link-Belt 160 excavator flipped on a flatbed trailer, with both tracks still on the trailer and the backside of the 38,400-pound machine hanging off. A Timbo's Construction Co. decal is visible on the excavator and a Forward Intermodal decal on the door of the cab. The Mississippi Highway Patrol and other law enforcement responded to the scene.
